



RICHFIELD PARKS AND RECREATION
BOARD MEETING
MARCH 4TH, 2019
MINUTES

The Richfield Village Parks and Recreation Board meeting was called to order at 6:33 pm.

ROLL CALL: Present were Sullivan, Kovak, Daniels and Stulak. Also present were Mayor Beshara, Councilman Domanick and Jocek.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A MOTION was made by Daniels and second by Kovak to approve the December 3, 2018 minutes as corrected. Motion approved.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Jocek reported that Council will discuss copy machines at Tuesday's meeting. Jocek stated that the recreation department has been without a copy machine for over 6 months.

Jocek reminded the Board that Project Pride will take place on Saturday, April 26th, 2019 from 9 am until noon. This event is when the community comes out to clean up the roadway.

Jocek stated that she is looking at the prices of rentals for the pavilions, Town Hall and Richfield Woods. The board discussed the fees and agreed to suggest the pavilion rental fees go from \$45/resident to \$60/resident for the Town Hall Pavilion and Richfield Woods Pavilion. The non-resident fee will go from \$100/non-resident to \$125/non-resident for the two pavilions. The fees for Fellowship and Masonic Hall will stay the same at this time.

MAYORS REPORT: Beshara reported that they have hired a new part time police person, Bill Sprit and also a part time dispatcher, Jody Meyer. Samantha Boryk, dispatcher, quit to take a full-time position in Hudson.

The Mayor reported that income tax is up 8% to date.

The Fire Department is doing a strategic planning session and community members are invited to participate. Bob Jones from the fire department will be retiring soon.

COUNCIL REPORT: Dr. Domanick reported that he is getting a lot of feed back on a community center.

TREE COMMISSION: Dr. Domanick reported that the Tree Commission talked about the "Adopt a Spot" project. He stated that there are 8-10 spots adopted.
