MAYOR'S REPORT:

- 3/14/2023 Mayor Wheeler attended the 1st of 2 record commission meetings on how long to keep records.
- 3/15/2023 Mayor Wheeler and Chief Swanson attended the Summit Safety Council lunch/meeting which included updates from an officer from OSHP with updates on the new distracted driver laws.
- Spoke on the Rise Against Hunger project coming up.
- Mayor Wheeler is on the Summit County digital equity steering program and they are tasked with trying to get affordable high-speed internet to all residents in the county. First meeting was on 3/17/2023
- Doug Wanger set up a meeting with USTA. USTA has agreed to furnish plans for the 8-pickleball / 2-tennis courts. They recommend 3 tennis courts, which is the minimum for holding little tennis leagues under high school age. Plans will include use of smart locks and lights.



OLD BUSINESS:

- Updates on new spaces for graves in West Richfield Cemetery- Scott Waldemarson said we are currently looking at adding about 48 new spaces into section 5/6 and need to buy the number markers for them
- There is about 10 unsold lots in section 5.
- Update on changing crypts to niches on the north side of the mausoleum in West Richfield Cemetery – ORDERED, 4 weeks out still
- Still working on final details of Columbarium plan for Fairview before we can put out for bid.

- Pat Healy made a motion to remove 945.03A, 945.05A & 945.07F from the cemetery rules. Vote was 5 ayes'
