

ORDINANCE NO. 25-2018

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF A PUBLIC STREET TO WIT: KINROSS LAKES PARKWAY EXTENSION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IX, Section 9.06 of the Charter of the Village of Richfield, the Planning and Zoning Commission must approve the construction of any public street; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission, on March 8, 2016, voted to approve the extension of Kinross Lakes Parkway; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2018, the Planning and Zoning Commission voted 5-0 to recommend to this Council the dedication of the extension of Kinross Lakes Parkway, as shown in the plat attached as Exhibit "A."


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The final plat for the extension of Kinross Lakes Parkway on the south side of Wheatley Road as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is accepted by Council and hereby dedicated as a public street bearing the name of South Kinross Lakes Parkway.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to approve the final plat and dedication of the extension of Kinross Lakes Parkway as a public thoroughfare within the Village of Richfield; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
