A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF PIERCE MANUFACTURING, INC. FOR A FIRE RESCUE PUMPER APPARATUS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received by the Service Director for the purchase of a fire rescue pumper apparatus for the Fire Department pursuant to Resolution 13-2014; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended that the bid of Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. be accepted by this Council, as being the lowest and best bid, in the amount of \$563,542.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Pierce Manufacturing, Inc., as being the lowest and best bid.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

- SECTION 1. The bid of Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. for a fire rescue pumper apparatus for the Fire Department in the amount of Five Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Three Dollars (\$563,542.00), being the lowest and best bid, is hereby accepted, in accordance with the Memorandum prepared by the Service Director attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated fully herein.
- SECTION 2. The Mayor and Finance Director are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. for the purchase of said fire rescue pumper apparatus pursuant to the bid.
- SECTION 3. That there be appropriated from the Fire Equipment Fund – Capital Equipment \$563,542.00.
- SECTION 4. That there be appropriated from the Income Tax Fund, transfer to the Fire Equipment Fund, \$198,000.00.
- SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village and for the further reason that it is necessary that the purchase of the emergency response equipment approved herein be made at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
