

RESOLUTION NO. 41-2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROAD SALT FROM CARGILL INC. DEICING TECHNOLOGY PURSUANT TO THE COMMUNITY UNIVERSITY EDUCATION (C.U.E.) PURCHASING ASSOCIATION PROGRAM FOR THE 2019-2020 WINTER SEASON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield, as a member of the C.U.E. purchasing program, may purchase road salt under the C.U.E.'s public bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended the purchase of road salt from Cargill Inc. Deicing Technology, through the C.U.E. program, for the 2019-2020 winter season.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. For the 2018-2019 winter season, the Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized and directed to purchase the Village's road salt requirements from Cargill Inc. Deicing Technology at \$71.89 per ton with a minimum order of 22-25 tons (full truck load) on a pay-as-you-go basis.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to procure needed road salt for the upcoming 2019-2020 winter season at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
