

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NOS. 4 AND 5 WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 2019 ASPHALT STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has previously entered into a contract with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. for the 2019 Asphalt Street Resurfacing Program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into Change Orders No. 4 and No. 5, as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 4, in the decrease amount of \$88,272.49, is a result of contract reconciliation concerning the original scope of the project having been completed; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 5, in the increase amount of \$69,253.80, represents the addition of paving work in the back drive at Richfield Woods (\$6,700), the drive of the entrance to the Richfield Woods Restroom (\$5,600), the aggregate section of the drive to Johnson's Barn (\$8,550), and the Recreation Center front parking area (\$42,108), plus a 10% contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into Change Order No. 4 with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. in the decrease amount of Eighty Eight Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars and Forty Nine Cents (\$88,272.49) from the contract heretofore authorized by this Council.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into Change Order No. 5 with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. in the increase amount of Sixty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$69,253.80) for additional paving work in the back drive at Richfield Woods, the drive of the entrance to the Richfield Woods Restroom, the aggregate section of the drive to Johnson's Barn, and the Recreation Center front parking area.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective in order to provide for the additional paving work described with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. for the 2019 Asphalt Street Resurfacing Program in

connection with project completion; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
