

RESOLUTION NO. 51-2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF A FIRE DEPARTMENT SQUAD VEHICLE TO UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has determined the Village has no use for Richfield Fire Department rescue Squad #3011, a 2008 Ford Chassis with a Horton Ambulance box (“squad”), that is of no value and is unneeded, obsolete, and unfit for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the Village, the Fire Chief has unsuccessfully attempted to sell the squad through online auction and by offering the vehicle for individual sale, with no potential purchasers identified; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has determined that University Hospitals, a non-profit 501(c)(3) entity, is willing to accept the donation of the squad; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village of Richfield to donate the squad to University Hospitals.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That RFD Squad #3011, a 2008 Ford Chassis with a Horton Ambulance box, is determined to be no longer fit for use by the Village, to be unneeded by the Village, and to have no value to the Village.

SECTION 2. That RFD Squad #3011 should be donated to University Hospitals.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor, Finance Director, and Fire Chief be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the donation to University Hospitals.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to remove the squad from the Village’s property inventory; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
