

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADA COMPLIANT RAMP FOR ACCESS TO THE SIDE ENTRANCE AT THE RICHFIELD HISTORICAL SOCIETY BUILDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for the construction of an ADA compliant ramp for access to the side entrance of the Richfield Historical Society Building; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended acceptance of the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. in the amount of \$127,850.00, as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., 525 Dan Street, Akron, Ohio 44310, in the amount of \$127,850.00, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted for the construction of an ADA compliant ramp for access to the side entrance at the Richfield Historical Society Building.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized to execute a contract with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., in accordance with the company's bid, and to add a 10% contingency amount to the contract.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow construction of the ADA compliant ramp at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
