

A RESOLUTION TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, STATE OF OHIO DURING THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2002

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. To provide for other expenditures of the said Village of Richfield during the year ending December 31, 2002 the following sums be, and they hereby are, set aside and appropriated as follows:

A) Capital Improvement Fund:

1) Service Department Vehicles	\$120,000
2) Tennis Courts Restoration/Design	53,600
3) Street Paving	200,000
4) Defibrillators (3) Police Cars	<u>8,400</u>

Total Capital Improvements **\$382,000**

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village for payments for any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board of officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make the expenditure; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with the law or Ordinance.

SECTION 3. In accordance with Section 4.12 of the Charter of the Village of Richfield, this Resolution No. 7-2002 will take effect and be in force upon the approval of the Mayor.
