

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) PUMPS FOR LIFT STATION NO. 2 ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS

WHEREAS, two (2) pumps are immediately necessary for Lift Station No. 2; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Revised Code Section 735.051.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase two (2) pumps for Lift Station No. 2 from Tri-State Pump Systems in an amount not to exceed \$15,500.00 each on emergency basis without the necessity of formal bidding and advertisement.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order for the continued operation of an essential Village department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
