

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 145.10 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE PERTAINING TO AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR ORIGINAL APPOINTMENTS OF POLICE OFFICERS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 145.10 of the Chapter 145 ("Division of Police") of the Administrative Code be enacted to read as follows:

"145.10 AGE FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

No person shall be eligible to receive an original full-time appointment to the Police Department unless the person has reached the age of twenty-one. Further, no person shall be eligible to receive an original full-time appointment in the Police Department when the person is thirty-five years of age or older."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
