

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 139.12 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ENTITLED "LIBRARY OPERATING FUND" AND TRANSFERRING THE FUNDS THEREIN TO THE GENERAL FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 139.12 of the Administrative Code entitled "Library Operating Fund" as the same existed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Revised Code Section 5705.14, the Finance Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to transfer the remaining balance in the Library Operating Fund to the General Fund.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary because the Library Operating Fund is no longer needed; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
