

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONSULTING AGREEMENT WITH JOHN WALSH FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, John Walsh recently retired as Chief of Police of the Village of Richfield; and

WHEREAS, during the interim, until a new Chief is hired and oriented, the Village is in need of the services of John Walsh on a consulting basis; and

WHEREAS, John Walsh is willing to serve as a consultant at the rate of \$40.00 per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a consulting agreement with John Walsh for professional services until a new Chief of Police is selected and oriented, which agreement shall be prepared and approved by the Law Director.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for essential Police services; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
