

ORDINANCE NO. 94-2001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 305.06 OF THE TRAFFIC CODE AND THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP TO PROVIDE FOR A THREE-WAY STOP AT BRUSH ROAD AND DEER CREEK TRAIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Traffic Control Map and Section 305.06 of the Traffic Code be amended as follows:

Three-way stop, at Brush Road and Deer Creek Trail.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for motor vehicle and pedestrian safety at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
