

RESOLUTION NO. 87-2014

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXPEND FUNDS FOR A HOLIDAY PARTY FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to expend up to nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) for a Holiday Party for the employees of the Village of Richfield; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that such Holiday Party is in the public interest of the Village of Richfield, to honor the Village's employees, and the Holiday Party constitutes a valid public purpose for the expenditure of Village funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to expend up to nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) to provide for a Holiday Party for the employees of the Village of Richfield and administrative officials.

SECTION 2. That Council hereby finds, determines and declares that the expenditure authorized herein serves a valid public purpose and is an appropriate use of Village funds.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing the aforementioned Holiday Party; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
