

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE SPECIAL COUNSEL TO THE DIRECTOR OF LAW, IN THE CASE OF K.S.T. OIL AND GAS COMPANY, ET AL VS. VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, INVOLVING AN ADMINISTRATIVE APPEAL AND MONEY DAMAGES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Pursuant to Section 8.01 of the Charter of this Village, Council deems it necessary to provide litigation services of special counsel to the Director of Law in connection with a claim now pending entitled K.S.T. Oil & Gas Company, et al, vs. Village of Richfield, et al, Common Pleas Court of Summit County, Ohio and indexed as Case Number 85-1-0194 on the records of that Court, and appoints the firm of Kelley, McCann and Livingstone for the provision of such services.

Section 2: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to be timely on required filings and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
