Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 2: Council extends to John Hill its best wishes for the years to come, in good health and spirit.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide appropriate best wishes and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
