

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF ENGINEERING SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the provision of engineering services requires peculiar skill and ability and aptitude; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of such personal services ^{is} an exception to the general requirements for competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, this Village desires to enter into a contract for the provision of engineering services with Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Limited;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield:

Section 1: Council finds and determines that the proposed contract with the engineering firm of Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Limited is a contract for the rendition of personal services and is an exception to the requirement for competitive bidding.

Section 2: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Limited, the proposed form of which is on file in the office the Director of Public Service and is approved.

Section 3: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to pay to such firm on presentation of proper documentation, such charges as are in accordance with the contract and to charge the proper account of this Village.

Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide engineering services and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by Law.
