The purpose of the proposed project is to extend the existing culvert carrying an unnamed tributary to the Furnace Run under Brecksville Road in the Village of Richfield. The outlet of the existing 5' x4' box culvert is badly eroded causing roadway berm and pavement failures.

The activities described herein, should they be authorized, have been designed to result in minor impacts to the unnamed tributary to Furnace Run. The proposed project will result in the preservation of Brecksville Road. Additionally, short term water quality impacts resulting from runoff of the disturbed areas during construction will be minimized through the use of sediment and erosion control measures. It is not anticipated that the proposed activities will result in long term degradation the unnamed tributary to Furnace Run or the Cuyahoga River watershed. Total avoidance of all streams for the project is not practicable.
