

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2018 2500HD CHEVY SILVERADO WITH TOWING AND SNOW PLOW PACKAGE FROM SERPENTINI CHEVROLET THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is a member of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to contract to purchase one (1) new 2018 2500HD Chevy Silverado with towing and snow plow package from Serpentine Chevrolet, 140 West Avenue, Tallmadge, Ohio 44278, as a replacement for an existing 2007 truck, under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, this purchase was approved as a part of the 2018 capital improvement budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and the Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase one (1) new 2018 2500HD Chevy Silverado with towing and snow plow package from Serpentine Chevrolet, 140 West Avenue, Tallmadge, Ohio 44278 for a total amount not to exceed \$31,862.63, under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program, as set forth in the proposal attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated fully herein by reference.


SECTION 2. That because this purchase is made under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program, this Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding or quotes pursuant to Section 141.03(f) of the Richfield Codified Ordinances.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to facilitate the acquisition of a replacement vehicle at the earliest possible time because the existing truck is a

2007 truck with 79,000 road miles and many work hours; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
