

RESOLUTION NO. 92-2018

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LOCKHART CONCRETE COMPANY FOR THE GLENCAIRN SANITARY SEWER PUMP STATION GENERATOR PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that a backup generator should be installed at the Glencairn sanitary sewer pump station (the Project); and

WHEREAS, the Village solicited bids for the Project pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has recommended that the contract for the Project be awarded to Lockhart Concrete Company as the lowest and best qualified bidder; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that Lockhart Concrete Company is the lowest and best qualified bidder and should be awarded the contract for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The bid of Lockhart Concrete Company in the amount of Seventy Nine Thousand and Nine Hundred Dollars (\$79,900.00) for labor and materials, being the lowest and best qualified bid received for the Project, is hereby accepted and approved and the Mayor and the Director of Finance of the Village are authorized to enter into and execute on behalf of the Village a contract with Lockhart Concrete Company in accordance with the specifications prepared for the performance of the Project, in accordance with the proposal submitted October 12, 2018 and GPD's recommendation dated October 19, 2018, attached as Exhibit A.


SECTION 2. The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow the Project to

move forward at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


