A RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY 9-1-1 PLAN AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE AMENDED SUMMIT COUNTY 9-1-1 PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield currently participates in Summit County's countywide 9-1-1 Plan in accordance with Ohio law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5507.08, any changes to the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan must be approved by municipal corporations within the County, including the Village of Richfield; and

WHEREAS, Summit County has proposed to amend the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan to include a new public safety answering point (PSAP) servicing Copley Township, the City of Norton, and the City of Barberton; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village's citizens, businesses, and visitors to approve of the proposed amendment to the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby approves the amendment to the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized to execute the proposed amended Summit County 9-1-1 Plan.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Dear Mayor Beshara,

Copley Township and the Cities of Norton and Barberton have formed the Southwest Summit Council of Governments (SWSCOG). Included in this formation is the consolidation of public safety communications. A new public safety answering point (PSAP) will be created for these three communities.

Per Ohio Revised Code, 5507.12 (4) (Amendment of a County 9-1-1 Plan), the Summit County 9-1-1 Planning Committee must reconvene to recommend this change. The Planning Committee met on May 29, 2013 and voted to approve SWSGOC.


Following the recommendation of the Summit County 9-1-1 Planning Committee, per Ohio Revised Code 5507.08 (A), "the legislative authority of each municipal corporation in the county and of each township whose territory is proposed to be included in a countywide 9-1-1 system shall act by resolution to approve or disapprove the plan."

I am requesting your assistance in executing this amendment to the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan by adopting a resolution to reflect this change no later than August 21, 2013.
