

RESOLUTION NO. 39-2011

A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD TO USE INTERNET AUCTIONS TO SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES AND OTHER PROPERTY REFERENCED IN REVISED CODE § 721.15 WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE OR ARE OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH THEY WERE ACQUIRED

WHEREAS, Revised Code §721.15 allows for this Council to adopt a Resolution authorizing the sale of personal property, including motor vehicles, and other personal property and equipment referenced in Revised Code §721.15, which is no longer needed for public use or obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was required, by Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to adopt such a Resolution expressing its intent to sell such surplus property by Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor and Finance Director to identify and enter into an agreement with an Internet auction entity to conduct such Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Clerk to advertise in a newspaper of general circulation this Council's notice of intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property by Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council further wishes to authorize the Clerk to post notice of the intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property on the Village's website throughout the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1: That this Council does hereby express its intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property by Internet auction. The Internet auction shall be conducted by an entity with whom the Mayor and Finance Director have entered into an agreement. Pursuant to Revised Code §721.15, the number of days for bidding on the property shall be no less than ten (10) days, including Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.

SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council be and hereby is authorized and directed to publish notice of this Resolution pursuant to Revised Code § 721.15 in a newspaper of general circulation in Richfield at least twice, the second and subsequent notice of publication being published not less than 10 nor more than 20 days after the previous notice.

SECTION 3: This Council further authorizes and directs the Clerk to post a notice of this Resolution in a conspicuous place in the offices of the Village Clerk as well as on the Village's website throughout the calendar year.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
