A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO DISPOSE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED BY THE VILLAGE DECLARED AS SURPLUS MUNICIPAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, this Council has received a recommendation from the Fire Chief that the following vehicle is no longer of service to the Village and should be declared as surplus personal property and disposed of: a 1998 Freightliner/Horton Squad with 122,000 miles, VIN: 1FV3EFBC8XH964015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1: That a 1998 Freightliner/Horton Squad with 122,000 miles, VIN: 1FV3EFBC8XH964015, is hereby declared to be surplus property of the Village and available for disposition through Internet auction. The Internet auction shall be conducted by LightGov, LLC, with whom this Council has previously authorized the Mayor to enter into an agreement.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
