

RESOLUTION NO. 43-2011

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CLEAN OHIO FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield has entered into a Purchase Agreement with Allstate Anti-Pollution Services, Inc. to purchase property located at 3969 Congress Parkway East, Richfield, Ohio, known as the Highpoint Trucking Project; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of purchase, the Village must perform a Phase II Environmental Assessment of the property; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield applied to the State of Ohio, Department of Development for Clean Ohio funds to perform the Phase II analysis on the High Point property, which application was approved; and

WHEREAS, the Phase II analysis on the property is currently underway; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield desires to participate in the Clean Ohio Assistance Fund program and/or the Clean Ohio Remediation Fund program to receive financial assistance for clean-up of the Highpoint Trucking Project property; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Richfield has the authority to apply for such financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Richfield must direct and authorize the Mayor to act in connection with the application.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Richfield authorizes the Mayor, as the official representative of the Village of Richfield, to file an application to participate in the State of Ohio Clean Ohio Assistance Fund and/or the Clean Ohio Remediation Fund, and provide all information and documentation required in the application for submission.

SECTION 2. That the Council for the Village of Richfield hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance under the Clean Ohio Assistance Fund and/or the Clean Ohio Remediation Fund.

SECTION 3. That the Council of the Village of Richfield hereby understands and agrees that participation in the program will require compliance with program guidelines.

SECITON 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of authorizing application for Clean Ohio funds in order that clean-up operations may be commenced at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
