

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR THE BRECKSVILLE AND HIGHLANDER ROADS CROSSWALK AND WALK EXTENSION CONSTRUCTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for the construction of a signalized crosswalk and sidewalk extension on the east side of Brecksville Road extending north to “Richfield Commons” plaza and south to the “Three Musketeers” restaurant along with additional sidewalk installation on the east side of Brecksville Road to improve crosswalk access at the intersection with Highlander Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended acceptance of the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. in the amount of \$109,093.60, as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., 525 Dan Street, Akron, Ohio 44310, in the amount of \$109,093.60, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted for the construction of a signalized crosswalk and sidewalk extension on the east side of Brecksville Road extending north to “Richfield Commons” plaza and south to the “Three Musketeers” restaurant along with additional sidewalk installation on the east side of Brecksville Road to improve crosswalk access at the intersection with Highlander Parkway.


SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized to execute a contract with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., in accordance with the company’s bid, and to add a 10% contingency amount to the contract.

SECTION 3. That there be appropriated from the Brecksville Road Paving Fund: Cost of Operations the sum of \$110,003.00; and that there be appropriated and transferred from the Income Tax Fund: Brecksville Road Fund the sum of \$50,000.00.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow construction of the improvements to increase pedestrian safety at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
