A RESOLUTION OPPOSING HOUSE RESOLUTION 3359 NOW PENDING IN THE U.S. HOUSE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE ON COMMERCIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE LAW

WHEREAS, there is currently pending before the House Judiciary Committee on Commercial and Administrative Law H.R. 3359; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the bill is to limit the authority of state and local governments to tax certain income; and

WHEREAS, H.R. 3359 requires the physical presence of an employee within a municipality for more than 60 days before their wages become subject to local income taxation; and

WHEREAS, this attack on municipalities' ability to raise revenues locally comes at a time when revenues are generally declining and the economy suffering; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to go on record as opposing H.R. 3359.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council does hereby go on record as opposing the passage of H.R. 3359.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to members of the Subcommittee on Commercial and Administrative Law, a list of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
