

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 27-2020 THAT ACCEPTED THE BASE BID OF PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 2020 ASPHALT ROAD PAVING PROGRAM, ACCEPTING THE BASE AND ALTERNATE BIDS OF PERRIN FOR THE 2020 ASPHALT PAVING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for the 2020 Asphalt Road Repaving Program; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director recommended acceptance of the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. ("Perrin") in the amount of \$995,450.00 which represents the base bid, being the lowest and best bid, noting that the foregoing bid was the lowest received; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2020, this Council passed Resolution No. 27-2020 accepting Perrin's base bid and further authorizing the Mayor and Finance Director to enter into a contract with Perrin accordance with the company's base bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council had further discussions on the Village's 2020 Asphalt Repaving Program at the May 13, 2020 work session and May 19, 2020 Council meeting and determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to include the alternate streets in the 2020 Asphalt Repaving Program by accepting Perrin's base bid and alternate bids No. 1-5, noting that the foregoing bids were the lowest received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 27-2020 accepting the base bid of Perrin and authorizing the Mayor and Finance Director to enter into a contract with Perrin in accordance with the company's base bid is repealed.

SECTION 2. That the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., 525 Dan Street, Akron, Ohio 44310, in the amount of \$1,634,061.55 representing the base bid of \$995,450.00 and bids for Alternate 1 (\$159,000.00); Alternate 2 (\$101,281.50); Alternate 3 (\$151,159.00); Alternate 4 (\$33,695.00); and Alternate 5 (\$44,925.00), being the lowest and best bids, be, and the same hereby are, accepted for the 2020 Asphalt Road Repaving Program.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized to execute a contract with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., in accordance with the company's bids, and to add a 10% contingency amount to the contract.

SECTION 4. That there be appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund: Cost of Operations \$134,062.

SECTION 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this

Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to authorize the 2020 Asphalt Road Repaving Program; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
