A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF CAVANAUGH BUILDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF THE VILLAGE GREEN PHASE I PARKING LOT RESTORATION AND STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received on March 24, 2015 for construction and installation of the Village Green Phase I parking lot restoration and stormwater management project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has analyzed the bids; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Cavanaugh Builders in the amount of \$312,000.00 has been recommended for acceptance as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Cavanaugh Builders for the construction and installation of the Village Green Phase I parking lot restoration and stormwater management project, at a cost of \$312,000, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide necessary sanitary sewer services at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
