

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION BY THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT 4 TO THE OHIO TRANSPORTATION REVIEW ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR FUNDING FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION AND WIDENING OF INTERSTATE 77 FROM GHENT ROAD TO THE OHIO TURNPIKE IN THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Interstate 77 is vitally important to the economic well-being of the Village;
and

WHEREAS, Ohio Department of Transportation (“ODOT”), District 4 is submitting an application to the Ohio Transportation Review Advisory Council (“TRAC”) for funding for the reconstruction and widening of Interstate 77 from Ghent Road to the Ohio Turnpike in the Village;
and

WHEREAS, the Village believes the reconstruction and widening of Interstate 77 from Ghent Road to the Ohio Turnpike will have a positive impact on the Village’s economy by mitigating heavy traffic congestion and safety problems; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to support ODOT District 4’s application to TRAC for funding for the reconstruction and widening of Interstate 77 from Ghent Road to the Ohio Turnpike in the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the Village of Village strongly endorses and supports ODOT District 4’s application to TRAC for funding for the reconstruction and widening of Interstate 77 from Ghent Road to the Ohio Turnpike in the Village.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this Resolution to give into effect in order to be included in ODOT District 4’s application for funding; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


