

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE A 2021 FREIGHTLINER LIFE LINE TYPE 1 AMBULANCE, HIGHLANDER MODEL, FROM PFUND SUPERIOR SALES CO., INC. THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO PURCHASING PROGRAM AND TO DECLARE A CERTAIN FIRE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO DISPOSE OF THE SURPLUS VEHICLE VIA TRADE-IN WITH THE SELLER AND TO APPLY THE TRADE-IN VALUE TOWARD THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE NEW AMBULANCE AND TO MAKE A PREPAYMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village is a member of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to purchase a 2021 Freightliner Life Line 1 Type 1 Ambulance, Highlander Model, from Pfund Superior Sales Co., Inc. ("Pfund") through the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended to Council that the following Fire Department vehicle, a 2012 GMC G-450 Squad VIN # 1GD67C14116848, is surplus property no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, and unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has advised Council that Pfund has agreed to a purchase the surplus property for \$40,000 in trade-in credits and apply the proceeds of the trade-in sale toward the purchase price of the new ambulance; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended that Council authorize a prepayment amount of \$220,000 for the new ambulance to take advantage of a prepayment discount that will save the Village an additional \$4,701.00 on the total purchase price of the new ambulance; and

WHEREAS, the trade-in and prepayment discount will result in a \$44,701 savings on the original purchase price of \$275,007 for the new ambulance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Finance Director are authorized and directed to purchase a 2021 Freightliner Life Line 1 Type 1 Ambulance, Highlander Model, from Pfund Superior Sales Co., Inc. for a total amount not exceed \$230,306 through the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Cooperative Purchasing Program, as set forth in the proposal attached as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein by reference.

- SECTION 2. Because this purchase is made under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program, this Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding pursuant to Section 141.03(f) of the Richfield Codified Ordinances.
- SECTION 3. The following Fire Department vehicle, a 2012 GMC G-450 Squad VIN # 1GD67C14116848, is declared surplus property no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, and unfit for the use for which it was acquired.
- SECTION 4. The Mayor and Finance Director are authorized and directed to sell and trade-in the surplus property listed in Section 3 to Pfund for not less than \$40,000 in credits and to apply the proceeds of the sale as trade-in toward the purchase price of the new ambulance.
- SECTION 5. The Mayor and Finance Director are authorized and directed to make a prepayment in the amount of \$220,000 toward the purchase of the new ambulance to take advantage of a prepayment discount and are further authorized and directed to pay the remaining \$10,306 balance at the time of delivery of the new ambulance.
- SECTION 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 7. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order for the new Fire Department Ambulance to be in use at the earliest possible time in the interest of public safety; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


