

A RESOLUTION DECLARING VARIOUS ITEMS OF VILLAGE PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SUPPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO SELL SAID PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, R.C. 721.15 allows for this Council to adopt a Resolution authorizing the sale by Internet auction of personal property, including motor vehicles, and other personal property and equipment which is no longer needed for public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, this Council adopted Resolution 10-2020 authorizing the sale, by Internet auction, of surplus Village personal property which is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired and authorized the Mayor to select a representative to conduct such Internet auctions; and

WHEREAS, this Council has received a recommendation from the Director of Public Service that the various items of personal property of the Village set forth in attached "Exhibit A" are no longer needed for public use, are obsolete, or are unfit for the use for which they were acquired and thus are surplus property that should be disposed of.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. This Council finds that various items of personal property of the Village, set forth in attached "Exhibit A," are no longer needed for public use, are obsolete, or are unfit for the use for which they were acquired, and, thus are surplus property and available for disposition by Internet auction and that an Internet auction shall be conducted by GovDeals.com.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the Village can expeditiously dispose of various items of personal property of the Village via Internet auction; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
