

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A FIRST RENEWAL INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, DIVISION OF ANIMAL CONTROL FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village passed Resolution No. 64-2015 that authorized and directed the Mayor and Finance Director to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for Animal Control Services (“Agreement”) with Summit County Department of Administrative Services, Division of Animal Control (“County”); and

WHEREAS, the 5-year Agreement between the Village and the County is set to expire on August 31, 2020 but allows the Village and County to renew the Agreement for one (1) additional five (5) year period; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended to Council renew the Agreement with the County for one (1) additional five (5) year period.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized and directed to enter a five (5) year First Renewal of Intergovernmental Agreement for Animal Control Services with Summit County, Department of Administrative Services, Division of Animal Control for a term to begin September 1, 2020, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to ensure that there is no disruption in the animal control services provided by the County to the Village; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
