

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY (20) BODY WORN CAMERAS, NINE (9) DASH MOUNTED CAMERA SYSTEMS, RELATED EQUIPMENT, SOFTWARE, AND SERVICES FROM WATCH GUARD UNDER THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to purchase twenty (20) body worn cameras, nine (9) dash mounted camera systems, related equipment, software, and services from Watch Guard, 415 E. Exchange Parkway, Allen, Texas 75002, through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- SECTION 1. The Mayor and the Finance Director are hereby authorized and directed to purchase twenty (20) body worn cameras, nine (9) dash mounted camera systems, related equipment, software, and services from Watch Guard, 415 E. Exchange Parkway, Allen, Texas 75002, for a total amount not to exceed \$127,373.31, as set forth in the proposal attached hereto as “Exhibit A” and incorporated fully herein by reference.
- SECTION 2. That because this purchase is made under the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, this Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding pursuant to Section 141.03(f) of the Richfield Codified Ordinances.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to facilitate the acquisition of a replacement body worn cameras for the Police Department because the current cameras are no longer suitable for the needs of the Police Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
