

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO THE MOBILE FIELD FORCE MULTI-JURISDICTION OPERATIONAL ASSISTANCE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AND EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, the Mobile Field Force Multi-Jurisdictional Operational Assistance Mutual Aid Agreement would authorize the Village's Mobile Field Force Unit to cooperate and assist other law enforcement agencies located with Summit County in order to respond to major spontaneous incidents, special events, or law enforcement emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended to Council that the Village enter into the MFU Agreement.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into the Mobile Field Force Multi-Jurisdictional Operational Assistance Mutual Aid Agreement with various law enforcement agencies located in Summit County substantially in accordance with the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference herein.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to implement the MFU Agreement at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
