A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO SUMMIT COUNTY / OHIO & ERIE CANALWAY COALITION, FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THE SUMMIT COUNTY TRAIL & GREENWAY COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Summit County / Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of developing trails and greenways; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield desires to participate by receiving financial assistance for development of trails and greenways under the Summit County Trail & Greenway Community Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the Summit County / Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition through its Summit County Trail & Greenway Community Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Village of Richfield authorizes the Mayor to file an application to participate in the Summit County / Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition through its Summit County Trail & Greenway Community Grant Program, and provide all information and documentation required in the application for submission.


SECTION 2. That the Village of Richfield hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance under the Summit County Trail & Greenway Community Grant Program.

SECTION 3. That the Village of Richfield hereby understands and agrees that participation in the program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.


SECTION 4. That the Village of Richfield hereby commits itself to provide the required local match investment as described in the application.
