

A RESOLUTION DECLARING VARIOUS ITEMS OF VILLAGE PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DONATE SAID PROPERTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, R.C. 721.15 allows for Council discard or salvage personal property if it determines the property is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired and has no value; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Director of Recreation has recommended that the various items of personal property of the Village set forth in attached Exhibit "A" should be discarded because the items of property are no longer needed for public use, are obsolete, and are unfit for the use for which they were acquired and have no value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. This Council finds that the various items of personal property of the Village, set forth in attached Exhibit "A," are no longer needed for public use, are obsolete, and are unfit for the use for which they were acquired and have no value.
- SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to donate the various items personal property set forth in Exhibit "A" and such property shall be donated to a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization located in Summit County.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the Village may expeditiously donate the personal property to a non-profit organization; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
