A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF HEMMINGER CONSTRUCTION FOR THE TOWN HALL REMODELING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2005, bids were accepted for the Town Hall Remodeling Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village's Consulting Architect has recommended acceptance of the bid of Hemminger Construction Company in the amount of \$2,745,900.00 together with Alternate E-2 in the amount of \$10,000, as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Hemminger Construction Company, together with Alternate E-2, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted for the Town Hall Remodeling Project.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to proceed with this important project at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
