A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO AUCTION EXCESS EQUIPMENT, FURNITURE AND VARIOUS OTHER ITEMS RECEIVED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Eddie Phister, Jr. to auction excess equipment, furniture and items received by the Police Department, a list of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to be effective prior to the November 5, 2005 auction; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
