

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF LIEUTENANT IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Police Chief have recommended the creation of the position of Lieutenant in the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created the position of Lieutenant in the Police Department.

SECTION 2. That the Chief of Police, in cooperation with the Mayor/Safety Director, shall create a job description for the position of Lieutenant in the Police Department. The position shall be incorporated into the flow chart attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3. The position of Lieutenant shall become effective January 28, 2002.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to become effective to create the position in the Police Department; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
