

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 147.01 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE INCREASING THE AUTHORIZED STRENGTH OF THE DIVISION OF FIRE BY TWO LIEUTENANTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council has received a recommendation from the Mayor and the Fire Chief that the authorized composition of the Division of Fire be increased by two (2) lieutenants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 147.01 of the Administrative Code be, and the same is, amended to read as follows:

“147.01 DIVISION OF FIRE ESTABLISHMENT; COMPOSITION.

There is hereby established in and for the Village a Division of Fire to be composed of a Fire Chief, an Assistant Fire Chief, not more than two Captains, not more than ~~two~~ four Lieutenants and not more than thirty Firefighters and such other officers and employees as Council shall from time to time determine.”

SECTION 2. That Section 147.01 of the Administrative Code as it existed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for full staffing at the Fire Department at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
