

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NOS. 1 AND 2 FOR THE COLUMBIA ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended change orders nos. 1 and 2 for the Columbia Road Reconstruction Project, copies of which change orders are attached hereto as Exhibits A and B.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County:

SECTION 1: That Change Order No. 1 (\$20,967.28) and Change Order No. 2 (\$31,909.69) be, and the same hereby are approved for the Columbia Road Reconstruction Project.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow for the closing out of the Columbia Road Reconstruction Project at the earliest possible time, wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
