

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 153.07(c) TO PROVIDE FOR SICK LEAVE PAYOUT FOR ALL FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE UPON RETIREMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 153.07(c) of the Administrative Code be amended to read as follows:

“153.07 SICK LEAVE.

(a) * * *

(b) Each full-time employee with ten or more years of service shall receive payment based on the employee’s rate of pay at retirement for unused accumulated sick leave up to a maximum accumulation of sixty days at retirement. Such retirement shall be in accordance with Public Employees Retirement System or Police and Firemen’s Disability Pension Fund.

(c) Subsection (b) hereof shall be in effect for all full-time Village employees hired on or after January 1, 1981, but shall not be in effect for all full-time Village employees hired on or after January 1, 1992. All full-time employees of the Village on the payroll on February 3, 1981, January 1, 1981 shall receive payment based on the employee’s rate of pay at retirement for all unused accumulated sick leave up to a maximum accumulation of 120 days at retirement. Such retirement shall be in accordance with Public Employees Retirement System or Police and Firemen’s Disability Pension Fund.

(d) * * *

(e) * * *”

SECTION 2. That Section 153.07(c) in effect prior to the effective date of this Ordinance be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
