

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO GO TO AUCTION FOR TWO MOTOR VEHICLES DECLARED AS EXCESS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Service Director has requested authorization to go to auction for a 1994 Ford Crown Victoria and a 1980 Mack Tanker in accordance with Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein fully as if by reference; and

WHEREAS, this Council does hereby declare these two motor vehicles excess equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to go to auction for the sale of a 1994 Ford Crown Victoria and a 1980 Mack Tanker.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide disposal of excess Village equipment at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
