

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF 480 HOURS OF SICK TIME TO RAYMOND L. NOTARIAN

WHEREAS, Raymond L. Notarian resigned on August 31, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Raymond L. Notarian was first hired on June 6, 1979 as a part-time Police officer; and

WHEREAS, Raymond L. Notarian served as our D.A.R.E. Officer for many years and became known as "Officer Ray" to Richfield's youth; and

WHEREAS, Raymond J. Notarian was hired as a full-time Police officer on November 12, 1989 and was promoted to Sergeant on September 4, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Richfield Code Section 153.07(a) and (b) requires in order to receive payment for accumulated sick time the employee must serve ten (1) years full-time service and retire from service; and

WHEREAS, inasmuch as Raymond L. Notarian has served more than ten (10) years service, this Council, in light of the extraordinary service and devotion that Raymond L. Notarian has rendered to the Village, wishes to waive the retirement requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to pay Raymond L. Notarian 480 hours of accumulated sick time.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
