

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 95-2001 WITH RESPECT TO A CHANGE ORDER TO THE M. W. MIELKE COMPANY FOR THE SAFETY BUILDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 95-2001 authorizing Change Order No. 28 to the M. W. Mielke Company for the Safety Building in the amount of \$22,978.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council has been informed that the correct figure for the Change Order should have been \$40,948.54.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 95-2001 is hereby amended to increase the amount of Change Order No. 28 to the M. W. Mielke Company for the Safety Building from \$22,978.00 to \$40,948.54.

SECTION 2. That in all other respects, Resolution No. 95-2001 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to pay for necessary change orders to the Safety Building at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
