

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO AUCTION VARIOUS EXCESS EQUIPMENT FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and hereby is, authorized to auction the following excess equipment for sale:

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to dispose of unneeded excess equipment in the Fire and Service Departments; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
