

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR ON BRECKSVILLE ROAD IN THE CONSTRUCTION AREAS FOR THE OHIO TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there are currently construction areas on Brecksville Road for the Ohio Turnpike interchange; and

WHEREAS, these construction areas restrict traffic to one lane controlled traffic; and

WHEREAS, this Council has been advised that the Chief of Police recommends a maximum 25 mile per hour speed limit in these zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That during construction of the Ohio Turnpike interchange on Brecksville Road the prima facie lawful speed for the operator of a motor vehicle to operate the same at a speed 25 miles per hour is hereby established.

SECTION 2. That the Chief of Police, in conjunction with the Service Director, be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to cause the posting of this speed limits by appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. That a violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a violation of Richfield Code Section 303.99(d).

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to be in force during the construction period; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
