

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR A PROGRAM YEAR 27 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Service Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to make application for a Program Year 27 Community Development Block Grant for the senior citizen programs of snow removal, leaf removal and emergency medical alerts in accordance with a memorandum from the Summit County Department of Development dated May 30, 2000, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

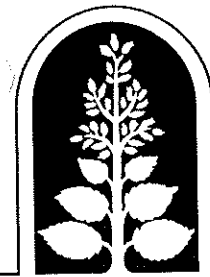

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to make timely application for CDBG monies; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

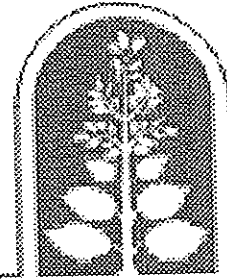
