

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REQUEST FOR ANNEXATION OF APPROXIMATELY 2.1579 ACRES OF LAND AND INDICATING SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED THERETO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Council has been notified of a Petition for Request for Annexation of approximately 2.1579 acres of land which has been filed with the Summit County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to indicate its acceptance and approval of said Petition for Annexation; and

WHEREAS, this Council further wishes to indicate the services to be provided to the annexed territory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That this Council hereby acknowledges receipt of the Petition for Annexation of 2.1579 acres in Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield, which Petition was accepted by the Summit County Council on October 30, 2000.
- SECTION 2. This Council hereby indicates that all Village services except garbage, including, but not limited to, police, fire and service, will be provided to the territory proposed for annexation upon annexation.
- SECTION 3. That this Council hereby declares its intent to accept dedication of the proposed annexation when presented pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.04.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason to be effective by the October 30, 2000 hearing before the Summit County Council; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect

immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
